



Thomas P. Kimbis is Director of Policy and Research and General Counsel at Solar Energy Industries Association (SEIA). Mr. Kimbis leads the development of long-term policies promoting solar energy, oversees expansion of SEIA's market research efforts, and provides legal services to SEIA as General Counsel. Prior to joining SEIA, Mr. Kimbis served as Executive Director of The Solar Foundation where he formed a new Board of Directors, led the organization into a new strategic direction, secured significant funding and established strategic partnerships. Mr. Kimbis currently serves as Chairman of the Board of The Solar Foundation.

From 2005-2009, Mr. Kimbis served as the Director of Market Transformation for the Solar Energy Technologies Program (SETP) at the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), where he led efforts to understand barriers to and maximize opportunities for solar energy commercialization. While at DOE, Mr. Kimbis led the creation of the Solar America Cities program, a Federal-city partnership with 25 cities and more than 180 partner organizations designed to accelerate the adoption of solar energy technologies. He served as Acting Program Manager of SETP, managing a \$170 million investment budget in solar, the largest direct solar investment in the U.S. He was one of the creators of the \$1.5 billion *Solar America Initiative*. Prior to joining SETP, Mr. Kimbis worked across the DOE Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy analyzing energy efficiency and renewable energy matters, led the legislative affairs team, and served as a chief of staff.

Mr. Kimbis has spoken widely regarding solar markets and technology commercialization approaches; represented the U.S. in negotiations and missions with China, Japan, and the European Union; and co-chaired the energy generation committee of the Hawaii Clean Energy Initiative.

He is a graduate of Williams College and the University of Virginia School of Law. Mr. Kimbis also maintains a Certificate in Public Leadership from the Brookings Institution and a Certificate in Excellence in Management from the American Management Association. He is a member of the Executive Committee of the Society of Alumni of Williams College.
